#### YEAR 4 - IN THE NET

As I am sure you are aware, internet safety of children across the UK has been in the news recently and continues to be a concern.

We know that the best protection we can give to young people is knowledge of the dangers so that they are aware and can protect themselves, as well as letting them know where they can go for help and support with regards to Cyber Bullying.

In order to do this, we are presenting an interactive play to our Year 4 pupils on 23<sup>rd</sup> June which will tackle some of the issues around Safe Internet Use, Cyber Bullying and prevention of exploitation. The play is age appropriate and is called 'In the Net'.

It will last for approximately 40 minutes and pupils will be provided with a support pack at the end of the production.

This activity is part of a programme of work around raising and tackling the complex nature of Internet Use and is being supported by the Education and Early Years Sub Group of the Gloucestershire Safeguarding Children Partnership (GSCP).

We hope that this will be a memorable way to enhance their safe internet usage and help our young people to stay safe on-line.

The children will travel in a staff car to and from the location. There is no change to drop off and pick up times.

Consent forms have been sent home and need to be returned by 16th June 2023.


