Tests

Well done to all children for completing
assessments at the beginning of term -
these will enable us to identify any gaps in
learning so that we can tailor our lessons
and support to help children make the
best possible progress.

New approach to writing

We are adopting the write stuff approach
which is championed by an award winning
educator Jane Considine, with focuses on
rich vocabulary and provides modelled
writing to support children.

Illness advice and COVID

If your child is ill with any of the
following:

- A temperature of 37.8
degrees celcius or higher
- A new and continuous
cough
- Loss of taste or smell

They must be kept at home for 10
days and the household should
isolate for 14 days unless a
COVID test shows they are
negative. If the test is negative,
and your child no longer has
symptoms they can come back to
school. If your child continues to
have symptoms they should
continue to stay away from school
and consider testing again after a
few days. If the test is positive,
your child needs to stay off school
for at least 10 days (longer if
they still have symptoms) and any
siblings need to stay off school
for 14 days. Please let the school
know immediately if your child or
anyone in the family has a positive
COVID test result. If there are
no tests available on line please
keep checking as more are made
available throughout the day.
