HOLIDAY FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Applications for Holiday Free School Meal vouchers for spring holidays are now open until the 21 March. Voucher emails will be sent out on 27 March. Please encourage parents to check their junk/spam email folders during this period as sometimes the vouchers end up there.

If parents have not received their vouchers by the 28 March please encourage them to email <u>childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk<mailto:childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk</u>> so that we can look into it.

This spring holiday, Gloucestershire County Council are providing vouchers to eligible families who have signed up to our Holiday Free School Meals (FSM) scheme. These vouchers are provided by Gloucestershire County Council as part of our commitment to 'no child goes hungry'. The vouchers are funded through grant funding we have received, and they are separate to that of term time free school meals.

The scheme is for children in reception to year 11 who receive benefits-related free school meals and attend a school in Gloucestershire. We are unable to consider college and sixth form students, as well as children who receive infant free school meals (available to all children from reception to year 2), as they are not eligible for this scheme.

Families who have signed up to the scheme or who are already registered will receive a total of £15 per child, for 1 week of the spring holiday, whilst the Holiday Activity and Food programme (HAF) provides for the second week of the holiday.
